Disability Access Auditor Training

An intensive level 3 accredited training course lasting 3 months leads to a professional qualification to practise as an Access Auditor. People who are disabled and/or economically inactive and seeking to return to sustainable employment may be eligible to get their course fees paid by Jobcentre Plus.

Other courses, including trainer (Disability Equality) and Business Advisor (Disability) are also available. For more information about courses, ring David Ormerod of Disability East on 01245 608312.
